



CHILDREN'S CLASSES

FRENCH FOR PRE-SCHOOLERS



ABOUT

This class is designed for children aged 3 to 5 and aimed at discovering and practicing oral French. It is tailored for families with a francophone parent at home or interested in the French bilingual program at Killarney Heights Public School (KHPS) but with children too young to join yet. This class mixes discovery, play, crafts and speaking. Ideal for younger siblings of children already in the program and to prepare a future integration.

PEDAGOGY

- Small groups of children both anglophone and francophone mixed in a friendly and homely environment.
- Progressive introduction of language through oral routines ("Je m'appelle...", "j'ai 4 ans", "C'est Lundi", "il fait beau" ...)
- activities (story reading, cooking, little crafts...) adapted to age group.

IS THIS FOR MY CHILD?

This class is targeted to anglophone and francophone children whose parents are interested in providing them a taste for foreign languages and prepare them for a bilingual education. No pre requisites are needed: children at this age will catch up extremely fast! Commitment from parents to participate, support and share activities with children is definitely a plus.

COURSE DETAIL

4 Terms of 9 sessions

Each session: 1.30 hours

Each Term will cover 3 to 6 topics like:

- Colours
- Numbers
- Seasons and Weather
- Emotions
- The body
- ...

Every term, at least one activity linked with seasonal events like Mother's Day, Father's Day, Easter... with a production in French to present to parents (song, card, drawing...)

ORGANISATION

Groups: 5 to 8 participants

Location: TBD in Forestville.

Timings: mornings. Days to be confirmed.

Cost: \$35.00/session. Minimum 2 terms.
