



FRENCH FOR PARENTS

ADULT CLASSES



ABOUT

This class is designed for adults willing to support their child who learns French at primary school. It has been designed with teachers from the KHPS French bilingual program to aid parents to accompany their children as they learn French, converse with them and check their homework.

A good opportunity to learn French together and share a fun family activity.

PEDAGOGY

Small groups of non-French speaking parents convinced of the benefits of bilingualism for their children, with a motivation to support them while you both learn French. The focus will first be on reading and speaking in French with the progressive introduction of grammatical concepts and vocabulary. In this class you will learn about numbers, colours, seasons, the body, animals and everything necessary to read and explain a story in French

You will be able to check your child's homework and practice conversation with them at home. Motivation and willing to practice is essential!

The teachers will be able to share with parents some resources to help them accompany their child like links to songs and videos, advice for story books to borrow or buy. They will also support parents to help them with their child's speech exercises.

IS THIS FOR ME?

This class is targeted at anglophones (or non French speakers) Your child is in the Anglophone program at Killarney Heights Public School or has started learning French in high school? You wish to understand and be able to help him/her with their homework? You would like to read stories together and converse a bit with your child to help improve their oral and reading skills? Then this course is for you! It will also be a great way to meet other KHPS parents as well!

COURSE DETAIL

4 Terms of 9 sessions
Each session: 2 hours

Each Term will cover concepts studied by children at school in their first two years of French as a foreign language. At the end of the year, parents should be able to communicate in French and help their children until the end of their second year.

The focus will be mainly on reading and simple written production adapted to what will be expected from anglophone children in the bilingual program at KHPS.

OTHER INFO

Classes will be groups of 5 to 8 participants to be held at the Forestville Community Centre

Timings- TBD . Cost \$35.00/session of 2 hours with a minimum of 2 terms enrolment. The course runs on a school term of 10 weeks (\$350.00/term).
